a The park is located in mid-Wales in the UK. It was established in 1957. It is the first National Park in the United Kingdom to achieve Geopark status, and it is also the first Geopark in Wales. By day, there are moorlands, trails and towns to discover, while by night, you can feast your eyes on the stars.

b It became the first National Park in 1951 in Britain. It covers 1438 sq. km. The park's name derives from an Old English word meaning hill. Its high point is on Kinder Scout, a moorland plateau some 636 meters above sea level.

c It is located in the U.S. states of Wyoming, Montana, and Idaho. It was the first National Park in the U.S. and is also widely held to be the first national park in the world. The park is known for its wildlife and its many geothermal features, especially Old Faithful geyser. It has many types of ecosystems, but the subalpine forest is the most abundant.

d The park is located in northwestern Arizona. It was officially designated a national park on February 26, 1919. In 1903, President Theodore Roosevelt visited the site and said: "... Let this great wonder of nature remain as it now is... "

e It is a mountainous region in North West England. A popular holiday destination, it is famous for its lakes, forests and mountains. It was established in 1951 and, following a minor extension in 2016, now covers an area of approximately 2,362 sq. km. It was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2017.
